




#### **Health Fair Descriptions:**

# Pacific Outreach Health Fair Sacramento, CA

The Pacific Outreach Health Fair – Sacramento is held annually in the fall season at the Vietnamese Martyrs Church in the heart of Little Saigon in Sacramento. The health fair welcomes communities of all ethnic backgrounds and is geared towards serving underserved populations of the area with health screenings and relevant health information to promote healthier lifestyles. In the past, we invited organizations that provide social services to help attendees enroll in the Affordable Care Act. This health fair is an important intersection where we can bridge access to healthcare and preventive health screenings in our pursuit for a healthier community.

# • Pacific Family Health Fair Stockton, CA

The Pacific Family Health Fair is held every spring and has been at St. Luke's Catholic Church for the past 7 years. As the name suggests, the Pacific Family Health Fair is focused on serving families around University of the Pacific. In conjunction to providing preventative health screenings, VN CARES also invites local non-profit organizations that provide their respective services to benefit the community. The local community emphasis has been an integral part of our health fair. We also hold an Art and Essay Contest for local elementary and high school students that encourage children to think critically of how they can contribute to a healthier future. Exceptional contest entries are awarded monetary prizes for their messages and efforts. Essentially, the Pacific Family Health Fair is a three prong approach in engaging the community by providing free health screenings, bringing community resources, and hosting a scholarship contest to make a multi-generational impact for our community.
